



New Jersey Film Academy FAQ's

- **Do I need to take the Intro course?** Yes. All students must pass “Script to Screen: Introduction to the entertainment Industry” before they can take another course to be certified.
- **Can I take the Intro course along with one of the other courses from the tracks?** All must take Script to Screen before they can move onto other courses.
- **How much will the classes cost?** NJFA Courses are very reasonably priced and scholarships are available while supplies last.
- **What's the schedule for the Intro class?** Please check with your local community college to see schedules.
- **What will I be able to do with the credential given at the end of the program?** Once you are certified you will be able to be listed as a credential holder on the njproductionguide.org as a credential holder. We will work with each student to advise on internships as well as how to make introductions with employers.
- **Where will courses be held?** All NJFA Courses are in person. Each college will publish where and when courses will take place.
- **When will the other courses be open?** Courses will come online as soon as opportunities are available.
- **Is the NJFA partnered with the big studios?** The Academy has relationships with every studio across the state but makes no promises to students for guaranteed job placement.
